Minutes of the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Clinton, Illinois in session in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Monday, August 15, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Roger Cyrulik, presiding. On roll call, Commissioners Ballenger, Edmunds, Crang and Wise were present.

Written motion was made by Commissioner Crang and seconded by Commissioner Wise that the minutes of the regular meeting of August 1, 2016 be approved as submitted. On roll call vote, Commissioners Edmunds, Crang, Wise, Ballenger and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

The bills and payroll were read.

Written motion was made by Commissioner Edmunds and seconded by Commissioner Crang that the bills and payroll be allowed as read and the Clerk be instructed to issue warrants on the Treasurer for the several amounts. On roll call vote, Commissioners Crang, Wise, Ballenger, Edmunds and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

#### **PETITIONS AND COMMUNICATIONS**

Greg Taylor from the Clinton Rotary presented a check to the City for \$8,000.00 for partial re-payment for the Park Project at Rotary Park. He stated that this is a Three Phase Project and Phases 1 & 2 (Pickle ball courts and playground equipment) are complete with Phase 3 being a multi-use pathway.

#### **REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS**

Mayor Cyrulik reported that the concert on July 30<sup>th</sup> was a success and there are two more concerts scheduled on August 20<sup>th</sup> and September 10<sup>th</sup>. He also stated that the street projects are looking good.

#### **REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF STREETS & PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS**

Commissioner Crang reported that the street projects are not quite complete with the recent weather but they are very close.

#### **REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC PROPERTY**

Commissioner Wise reported that a crew working at the Hospital hit a valve and the water had to be turned off but the Hospital was prepared for this kind of emergency. He thanked all the departments for their help. He also stated how the different entities work together in the community and he was thankful for that.

## **REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH & SAFETY**

Commissioner Ballenger had no report.

Engineer Brandon Robinson reported that the 1999 Pierce Pumper, which is used on rural operations, needs a new radiator. After Council discussion, the 1999 Pierce Pumper (Unit 6) was put on file not to exceed \$6,000.00 from Global Emergency Products.

## **REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTS & FINANCES**

Commissioner Edmunds reported the Sales Tax was \$262.00 behind this time last year and the Non-Home Rule Sales Tax is \$1,000.00 ahead.

## **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

Written motion was made by Commissioner Ballenger and seconded by Commissioner Edmunds to approve Resolution 2016-15, A Resolution Authorizing Execution of a School Resource Officer Intergovernmental Agreement. On roll call vote, Commissioners Wise, Ballenger, Edmunds, Crang and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".
