Minutes of the reconvened meeting of the City Council of the City of Clinton, Illinois in session in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Thursday, September 20, 2007 at 7:30 a.m. Mayor Ed Wollet, presiding. On roll call Commissioners Edmunds and Milton were present. Commissioners Hickman and Wise were absent.

Mayor Wollet noted that the sole purpose of the reconvened meeting is to consider Resolution approving application for Illinois Municipal Assistance from Northern Illinois University Center for Government Studies. This program was discussed in depth at the 17th meeting citing an urgency to get the City's application submitted within a very short window to be considered for the program. Motion was offered.
