Minutes of the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Clinton, Illinois in session in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Monday, February 20, 2012. Mayor Carolyn Peters, presiding. On roll call, Commissioners Edmunds, Milton and Crang were present. Commissioner Wise was absent.

Written motion was made by Commissioner Milton and seconded by Commissioner Crang that the minutes of the regular meeting of February 6, 2012 be approved as submitted. On roll call vote, Commissioners Edmunds, Milton, Crang and Mayor Peters voted "Yes".

The bills and payroll were read.

Written motion was made by Commissioner Edmunds and seconded by Commissioner Milton that the bills and payroll be allowed as read and the Clerk be instructed to issue warrants on the Treasurer for the several amounts. On roll call vote, Commissioners Edmunds, Milton, Crang and Mayor Peters voted "Yes".

PETITIONS AND COMMUNICATIONS

Mayor Peters read a proclamation for the American Red Cross and was presented with a First Aid Kit.

REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS

Mayor Peters received two notices from IEPA and also the renewal permit and provided copies.

She stated that ten people went to the tour of the Clinton Landfill on February 16, 2012 and they went over what they do with the recycle products.

REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF STREETS & PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS

Commissioner Crang reported that with the good weather the Street Dept. has been doing daily routine work.

REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC PROPERTY

Commissioner Wise was now present at the meeting. He reported that the work on the main improvement project has started on the east end of town by BFI Stericycle. He also wanted to thank everyone who is working on the budget.

REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH & SAFETY

Commissioner Milton had no report.

REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTS & FINANCES

Commissioner Edmunds reported that the sales tax received in February was \$110,592.00 which was the highest amount ever received in February.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Written motion was made by Commissioner Milton and seconded by Commissioner Edmunds to approve the purchase of 2 cases Federal AE40R3 and 40SW165 and 2 cases Federal T223A which is ammunition for the Police Dept. from Kiesler Police Supply, Inc. in the amount of not to exceed \$1,137.30 + shipping. On roll call vote, Commissioners Edmunds, Milton, Crang, Wise and Mayor Peters voted "Yes".

Written motion was made by Mayor Peters and seconded by Commissioner Wise to approve the Tree Tracker Inventory Management Software for the Tree City Commission in the amount of \$1,800.00. On roll call vote, Commissioners Edmunds, Milton, Crang, Wise and Mayor Peters voted "Yes".

Written motion was made by Commissioner Milton and seconded by Commissioner Edmunds for the repair/purchase and implementation of a radio system for the Fire Dept. in the amount of \$800.00. On roll call vote, Commissioners Edmunds, Milton, Crang, Wise and Mayor Peters voted "Yes".

NEW BUSINESS

On File – Handset for Base Radios/Fire Dept. - \$1,853.01 – Chief Milton explained that this will be replacing the handset that they have now which is over twenty years old.

ADJOURNMENT

With no further business to come before the Council, a motion was made by Commissioner Edmunds and seconded by Commissioner Milton to adjourn the meeting. Voice vote was taken. Motion was unanimous.
