

June 15, 2015

Minutes of the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Clinton, Illinois in session in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Monday, June 15, 2015. Mayor Roger Cyrulik, presiding. On roll call, Commissioners Crang, Wise, Ballenger and Edmunds were present.

Written motion was made by Commissioner Ballenger and seconded by Commissioner Wise that the minutes of the regular meeting of June 1, 2015 be approved as submitted. On roll call vote, Commissioners Wise, Ballenger, Edmunds, Crang and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

Written motion was made by Mayor Cyrulik and seconded by Commissioner Ballenger to approve the work done at the Spray Park by Kinder Company in the amount of \$4,194.06. On roll call vote, Commissioners Ballenger, Edmunds, Crang, Wise and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

The bills and payroll were read.

Written motion was made by Commissioner Edmunds and seconded by Commissioner Wise that the bills and payroll be allowed as read and the Clerk be instructed to issue warrants on the Treasurer for the several amounts. On roll call vote, Commissioners Edmunds, Crang, Wise, Ballenger and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

## **PETITIONS AND COMMUNICATIONS**

Steve Myers from Farnsworth Group addressed the Council and thanked them for working with his staff and to call if there is anything they can do for the City.

Mayor Cyrulik informed the citizens that the Bike Path will be signage and a line for the bike path and the City will do in-house work on the sidewalks and the Council needs to decide where to start and make a path to Weldon Springs to begin the project.

## **REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS**

Mayor Cyrulik reported he had been in the hospital and he received excellent care. The Hospital Interim CEO was present at the meeting and the Mayor reported he is doing a fine job with the Hospital.

## **REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF STREETS & PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS**

Commissioner Crang reported that the weather has been putting the staff behind in their work on the alleys and tree trimming but they are keeping busy picking up limbs and brush this week. She also stated that on July 4<sup>th</sup> the downtown square will be closed for Celebrate Clinton from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Commissioner Wise had no report.

## **REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH & SAFETY**

Commissioner Ballenger reported that the Eagles Club will be having several events coming up but their big event will be bringing 600 motorcycles in town and they will be escorted through town by the Police and Fire Depts.

Interim Fire Chief David Dallas reported that they have 8 new members (4 are returning) with a total of 35 members and they are doing a lot of training.

## **REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTS & FINANCES**

Written motion was made by Commissioner Edmunds and seconded by Mayor Cyrulik to approve the Proposal for Actuarial Consulting Services with Lauterbach & Amen, LLP for GASB 45 Actuarial Valuation for Fiscal Years 2015, 2016, 2017 in the amount of \$3,900.00. On roll call vote, Commissioners Crang, Wise, Ballenger, Edmunds and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

## **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

Written motion was made by Commissioner Crang and seconded by Commissioner Wise to adopt Ordinance #1377, An Ordinance of the City of Clinton, DeWitt County Illinois, Ascertaining the Prevailing Rate of Wages for Laborers, Workers and Mechanics Employed on Public Works of Said City. On roll call vote, Commissioners Wise, Ballenger, Edmunds, Crang and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

Written motion was made by Mayor Cyrulik and seconded by Commissioner Ballenger to approve the donation of \$3,700.00 to the Clinton Community Fire Works. On roll call vote, Commissioners Ballenger, Edmunds, Crang, Wise and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

Written motion was made by Mayor Cyrulik and seconded by Commissioner Wise to approve the purchase of 3 dozen (\$65.00 each) City Flags from Minerva in the amount of \$2,340.00. On roll call vote, Commissioners Edmunds, Crang, Wise, Ballenger and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

Written motion was made by Commissioner Ballenger and seconded by Commissioner Edmunds to approve the purchase of a Multi-Purpose K-9 for the Police Dept. from Steve Jostes, training and additional equipment – not to exceed \$10,000.00. On roll call vote, Commissioners Crang, Wise, Ballenger, Edmunds and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

Written motion was made by Mayor Cyrulik and seconded by Commissioner Wise to approve Resolution 2015-13, Resolution Authorizing Execution of Contract for the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Clinton and the United Association of Plumbers & Pipefitters, Local Union No. 137. On roll call vote, Commissioners Wise, Ballenger, Edmunds, Crang and Mayor Cyrulik voted “Yes”.

Written motion was made by Mayor Cyrulik and seconded by Commissioner Wise to approve the Letter of Understanding between the United Association of Plumbers & Pipefitters, Local Union No. 137 and the City of Clinton. On roll call vote, Commissioners Ballenger, Edmunds, Crang, Wise and Mayor Cyrulik voted “Yes”.

Written motion was made by Mayor Cyrulik and seconded by Commissioner Ballenger to approve Resolution 2015-14, A Resolution Authorizing Execution of an Agreement for Participation in Facade Renovation with Taylor Abstract in the amount of \$3,983.25 (City’s portion). On roll call vote, Commissioners Edmunds, Crang, Wise, Ballenger and Mayor Cyrulik voted “Yes”.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

Written motion was made by Mayor Cyrulik and seconded by Commissioner Crang to approve the Agreement with Frontier Services for the Monthly Fee for Long Distance Service and the PRI Box for a 5 Year Agreement in the amount of \$21,300.00. On roll call vote, Commissioners Crang, Wise, Ballenger, Edmunds and Mayor Cyrulik voted “Yes”.
