Minutes of the public hearing on the EPA Low Interest Loan for the City of Clinton Water Department in session in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Monday, January 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6:45 p.m. Mayor Tom Edmunds, presiding. On roll call Commissioners Hickman, Wise and Milton were present.

Eric Carlson of MACTEC is working on a low interest loan in the amount of \$1,407,869 to fund 3 water improvement projects at 1.25% with a 25% principal forgiveness.

The first being the new water well, pump, well house and piping to tie into a raw water main at the north west corner of Kiwanis Park.

Second being the replacement of a 6-inch water main on Van Buren, White, Elm & Grant Streets. This section of the water main has deteriorated greatly and already has the engineering already completed.

Looping of a 6-inch water main on the east side near the Village apartments will give a better quality of water and address any pressure issues.

Looping a section near Rt. 10 & Weldon Springs will be the second part of the project. Both looping projects will also be a safety factor in case of a fire emergency in these areas.

A 15-day window will take place to take any public comment.

With no further questions or comments from those attending Mayor Edmunds adjourned the hearing.
