Minutes of the special meeting of the City Council of the City of Clinton, Illinois in session in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Wednesday, November 2, 2011. Mayor Carolyn Peters, presiding. On roll call, Commissioners Edmunds, Milton and Wise were present. Commissioner Crang was absent.

Ordinance #1235, An Ordinance Vacating Right-Of-Way beside the property at 1204 E. South St. was put on file on October 3, 2011 and passed and approved on October 17, 2011. Since that time the payment has not been made and the Mayor received an email from an interested adjoining landowner who expressed they were never properly notified. The Mayor feels this Ordinance needs to be rescinded and repealed and see if it is brought up again by the applicant for discussion at the Council meeting.

Tim Followell explained the usual procedure for the vacation of an alley. The requesting applicant does the paperwork and is to get approval from the affected landowners. An adjoining landowner initially agreed to the vacation of the alley, but the next day changed their mind, contacting Mr. Followell. Commissioner Crang was notified, talked to the requesting applicant and decided to proceed with the vacation of the alley.

Written motion was made by Commissioner Wise and seconded by Commissioner Milton that Ordinance #1235 is hereby rescinded and repealed. On roll call vote, Commissioners Edmunds, Milton, Wise and Mayor Peters voted "Yes".

ADJOURNMENT

With no further business to come before the Council, a motion was made by Commissioner Milton and seconded by Commissioner Edmunds to adjourn the meeting. Voice vote was taken. Motion was unanimous.
