Commissioner Ballenger reported that Rotary Park has been completed and he thanked everyone for their hard work on the project. The Mayor thanked Tim Followell and Steve Lobb for their work at the park.

Police Chief Lowers reported with the hot weather please check on the elderly and he also thanked Council for bringing the concert to the square and everything went very well.

Interim Fire Chief Dallas reported that the Fire Dept. has been busy with training and calls and they will be on the square on the 4th of July serving breakfast to the citizens and will be on standby for the fireworks that evening.

Commissioner Edmunds reported there was a \$7,000.00 increase in sales tax.
