Minutes of the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Clinton, Illinois in session in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Monday, December 5, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Roger Cyrulik, presiding. On roll call, Commissioners Crang, Wise, Ballenger and Edmunds were present.

Written motion was made by Commissioner Wise and seconded by Commissioner Crang that the minutes of the regular meeting of November 21, 2016 be approved as submitted. On roll call vote, Commissioners Wise, Ballenger, Edmunds, Crang and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

The bills and payroll were read.

Written motion was made by Commissioner Edmunds and seconded by Commissioner Ballenger that the bills and payroll be allowed as read and the Clerk be instructed to issue warrants on the Treasurer for the several amounts. REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS

REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC PROPERTY

Commissioner Wise thanked everyone who was in the Christmas Parade as he was out of town and he heard it was a great success and thanked all the departments for their work getting everything ready for the parade. He also reported there was another water main break at Evans & Stone late Friday night and residents had no water pressure. It was not a safety issue and the department addressed it early the next morning and fixed the problem but he wanted to stress that the Water Department can only replace things as they can afford it and it will be looked at in the near future.

REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH & SAFETY

Commissioner Ballenger had no report.

Police Chief Ben Lowers introduced the new police officer, Mack King and the City Clerk swore him in.

Interim Fire Chief David Dallas reported it has been slow on call volume and have a couple volunteers finishing up the first responders class and he reminded the citizens when putting up Christmas decorations not to overload extension cords and if you have a real Christmas tree keep it watered and have a safe holiday season and a Merry Christmas.

Written motion was made by Commissioner Edmunds and seconded by Commissioner Crang to adopt Ordinance #1422 (Barnes property), Ordinance #1423 (Black property), Ordinance #1424 (Clark property), Ordinance #1425 (Ryan property), Ordinance #1426 (Scherer property), Ordinance #1427 (Schmid property), An Ordinance Abating Taxes for Certain Territory in the City of Clinton, Illinois. On roll call vote, Commissioners Wise, Ballenger, Edmunds, Crang and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

Written motion was made by Commissioner Edmunds and seconded by Commissioner Ballenger to adopt Ordinance #1428 (\$1,500,000 General Obligation Bonds Series 2002), Ordinance #1429 (\$700,000 General Obligation), Ordinance #1430 (\$650,000 General Obligation), An Ordinance Abating the Tax. On roll call vote, Commissioners Ballenger, Edmunds, Crang, Wise and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

Written motion was made by Commissioner Edmunds and seconded by Commissioner Crang to adopt Ordinance #1431, An Ordinance Increasing Tax Rate for Street and Bridge Purposes and Ordinance #1432, An Ordinance Levying Tax for Street Lighting Purposes. On roll call vote, Commissioners Edmunds, Crang, Wise, Ballenger and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

Written motion was made by Commissioner Edmunds and seconded by Commissioner Crang to adopt Ordinance #1433, Annual Levy Ordinance. On roll call vote, Commissioners Crang, Wise, Ballenger, Edmunds and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

Written motion was made by Mayor Cyrulik and seconded by Commissioner Wise to adopt Ordinance #1434, Ordinance Authorizing Execution of Annexation Agreement (Joan I. Short Trust Property). On roll call vote, Commissioners Wise, Ballenger, Edmunds, Crang and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

Written motion was made by Mayor Cyrulik and seconded by Commissioner Edmunds to adopt Ordinance #1435, An Ordinance Annexing Certain Territory to the City of Clinton, Illinois (Short property). On roll call vote, Commissioners Ballenger, Edmunds, Crang, Wise and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

Written motion was made by Commissioner Crang and seconded by Commissioner Ballenger to approve the Disposal of Leaves in the amount of \$11,500.00 at the Yard Waste Facility by R & R Services of Illinois, Inc. (leaves only). On roll call vote, Commissioners Edmunds, Crang, Wise, Ballenger and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".
