Minutes of the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Clinton, Illinois in session in the Council Chambers of City Hall and electronically, Monday, September 21, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Roger Cyrulik, presiding. On roll call, Commissioners Edmunds, Wise and Ballenger were present. Commissioner Buchanan was absent.

Written motion was made by Commissioner Wise and seconded by Commissioner Ballenger that the minutes of the regular meeting of September 8, 2020 be approved as submitted. On roll call vote, Commissioners Wise, Ballenger, Edmunds and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS

REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF STREETS & PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS

Commissioner Buchanan was absent. City Administrator, Tim Followell reported that the first two blocks of E. Woodlawn St. in front of the Homestead would be blocked off from 2:30 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. for the drive-up pick-up of the ham & beans and ham sandwiches on Saturday, September 26th.

REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC PROPERTY

Commissioner Wise thanked Commissioner Ballenger and the Fire Dept. for bringing the fire trucks to help with lighting while working on a water main break last week that blew a huge hole in the road on W. Leander St. He also stated that the Water Plant is getting older and under New Business he asked to go ahead and approve the SCADA System for the Water Treatment Plant.

REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH & SAFETY

Commissioner Ballenger reported that citizens need to follow the rules of the golf carts with no children under the age of 8 to be riding on the golf carts.

REPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTS & FINANCES

Commissioner Edmunds reported an increase in both sales taxes of \$18,000.00 and that is a positive for the City.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Written motion was made by Commissioner Ballenger and seconded by Commissioner Wise to approve the Purchase of 15 Glock Gen 5 Model 17 Semi-Automatic Handguns for the Police Dept. from Kiesler Police Supply in the amount not to exceed \$5,000.00. Written motion was made by Commissioner Wise and seconded by Commissioner Ballenger to adopt Ordinance #1521, An Ordinance Pertaining to the Local Cure Program. On roll call vote, Commissioners Wise, Ballenger, Edmunds and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".

NEW BUSINESS

Written motion was made by Commissioner Wise and seconded by Commissioner Ballenger to approve the Engineering Proposal for the SCADA System at the Water Treatment Plant from Donohue & Associates, Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$10,000.00. On roll call vote, Commissioners Ballenger, Edmunds, Wise and Mayor Cyrulik voted "Yes".
